1.	Head west on W Lawrence Ave toward N Kostner Ave	0.9 mi
2.	Slight right to merge onto I-90 W/Kennedy Expy W	5.1 mi
3.	Slight right at I-190 W (signs for I-294 S/O'Hare Int'l Airport/Indiana/I-190 W)	1.2 mi
4.	Take exit 1D on the left to merge onto I-294 S toward Indiana	
5.	Partial toll road	6.8 mi
6.	Take the exit onto Eisenhower Expy W/I-290 W toward Rockford/US-20/IL-64	0.3 mi
7.	Take exit 13B for N Ave/IL-64 W	0.2 mi
8.	Merge onto IL-64 W/E North Avenue	0.4 mi

NAMAZ-E-WAHSHAT

These prayers are offered in connection with the fear caused by loneliness in the grave of the dead person

After the deceased has been buried, it is recommended to recite salatu't- wahshat. This namaz can be said at any time of that night although it is better to say it after the 'isha prayer .

Namaz-e wahshat is to be recited once by the wali of the deceased or by someone who has been asked by the wali to do that namaz. The method of offering these Prayers is as follows:

- 1st Rak'at** Surah Al-Hamd followed by Ayatul Kursi (once)
2nd Rak'at Surah Al-Hamd followed by Surah Al-Qadr (10 times)

After saying Salaam, recite :

Alla Humma Saali, Ala Muhammadin Wa Ale Muhammad Wab'ath Thawabaha Ila Qabri

(full name(s) of the deceased)

HADIYA-E-MAYYAT

Namaz-e Hadya-e Mayyit means the salat that is done for sending its reward as gift to deceased person(s).

This salat can be done at any time, as many times, and for as many deceased people as possible,

Namaz-e Hadya-e Mayyit can be said like the morning prayer; only the niyyat (intention) will change. However, it is better to do this namaz in the method taught by Imam Ja'far As-Sadiq (AS) as follows:

- 1st Rak'at** Surah Al-Hamd followed by Surah Al-Qadr (once)
2nd Rak'at Surah Al-Hamd followed by Surah Al-Kawthar (once)
